A. CONFERENCES/WORKSHOPS

Level 1 (online)

- Opening Conference (5 days, incl. *Ontological Coaching in Action Workshop*) – 23, 25, 27, 29 and 31 March 2021
- Mid-Level Conference (2 days) – 4-5 June 2021

Level 2 (in-person)
